

# Semester in Spain Intensive Spanish I and II

This intensive Spanish I and II course is mandatory. In addition, students are eligible to take 2 or all 3 electives.

### **Description**

These courses are designed to be the equivalent of SPAN 3201 and SPAN 3202 as described in the <u>UNC Charlotte Catalogue</u>. Together they provide a complete review of Spanish grammar as well as oral and written practice. If students have already taken SPAN 3201 and/or SPAN 3202, they can do additional work and have the courses count as SPAN 4050, which is an elective Spanish course.

# **Objectives**

- 1. Students will be prepared to give formal oral presentations in an academic setting.
- 2. Students will be prepared to write academic papers in Spanish for college-level classes.
- 3. Students will be able to explain the grammatical concepts they use.
- 4. Students will improve their level of oral fluency to at least an Advanced level on the ACTFL speaking proficiency scale.

#### **Evaluation**

Students will be evaluated on the following requirements:

- 1. Class participation (attendance is mandatory—no more than 3 absences will be permitted. Students are responsible for making up any missed work) (20%).
- 2. Homework exercises (20%)
- 3. Written assignments and revisions (20%)
- 4. Oral presentations (formal and informal) (20%)
- 5. Final exam (20%)

**Note:** Students who have completed SPAN 3201 and/or SPAN 3202 (or their equivalents) prior to the program will be given credit for SPAN 4050 Special Topics in Spanish, **subject to** additional work approved by the instructor.
